## 4. Reports/Updates

- Discussion regarding lack of welcome staff, front desk staffing at TVC. Students are confused. Safety concerns. It has been reported Wifi does not allow access to use cell phones.
- Discussion for Union President and Vice President to meet with Academic Senate President to increase collaboration.
- Update for Non-Teaching faculty evaluations. Assigned Dean will evaluate entire load, to include overload teaching assignments.
- The Full-Time faculty evaluation process was discussed in relation to teaching assignments. Discussion regarding separate and distinct evaluation forms need to be developed for all modalities- online, hybrid, "Real Time" and on campus. Evaluation process should align with Ed Code.
